Dear Parents

It has been lovely to see some summery weather this week and to be able to do some of our learning outside. The children in K52 had a super day for their first federation afternoon of the year and enjoyed taking part in summer sports activities with Mr Windwood.

As per our federation sunscreen policy please could you make sure that your child has a sun hat which covers their ears and back of their neck, and also a named bottle of sunscreen in school with them each day. We also ask that parents apply sunscreen in the morning before children come to school.

School meal price increase

We are so lucky to have our own cook to prepare a nutritious, freshly prepared meal each day on each site. They work hard to ensure that they always provide good value for money and the cost of school meals has remained constant for several years now, however due to the increased staffing and food costs we will need to increase the cost of school meals after half term. Children in foundation stage and key stage one will still be eligible for free school meals, but for children in year 3 upwards the cost of a meal will now be £2.25 per day.

Reception and Year 6 height and weight

Next Friday morning a member of the healthy child team will be in school to measure the height and weight of Reception and Year 6 pupils as part of the National Child Measurement Programme. We have found in the past that they really enjoy this time together and it helps to settle them in to the school day so that they are ready for their tests at 9.15am. If the children wish to attend, please could they arrive by 8.20am.
